

Masonic Education

June 24th of this year marks a significant one indeed. It is the celebration of one of the Patron Saints of Freemasonry, St. John the Baptist. Our Illustrious Brother, Albert Mackey, quotes Dalcho in Volume II of his Masonic Encyclopedia, "The stern integrity of St. John the Baptist, which induced him to forego every minor consideration in discharging the obligations he owed to God; the unshaken firmness with which he met martyrdom rather than betray his duty to his Master; his steady reproval of vice, and continued preaching of repentance and virtue, make him a fit patron of the Masonic institution." (Encyclopaedia of Freemasonry, Volume II – pg.659). I could not have said it better myself regarding our allegiance to such a venerated individual as St. John the Baptist. We learn in our 1st degree long form lecture, that there is, or should be, represented in every regular Lodge a certain point within a circle. The circle being supported by two perpendicular parallel lines, which represent St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist. The initial teaching here is for the Entered Apprentice to circumscribe his passions to keep himself within due bounds.

June 24th also happens to be considered the Summer Solstice, the Midsummer and shortest day of the year. A deeper meaning behind the Point Within a Circle symbol, the point, the sun, the Centre of the solar system; the circle, the earth's orbit around the sun; the parallels, where they touch the circle, the winter and summer solstice. The limit of the sun's apparent course to the Northward and Southward of the Equator; the left hand perpendicular, B**Z or the Northern Pillar, the right hand perpendicular, J****N, the Southern Pillar, standing in the porch of the Temple of the Lord, which is the Universe. While the Bible, as now placed in the symbol, or more properly in our opinion the sun, as the symbol of divinity, has its place in the Orient. I believe this leads us to the conclusion as to why our great Fraternity didn't use St. Thomas as our Patron Saint, who was the patron Saint of architecture and building.

The summer and winter solstices were two pagan holidays that continued to remain popular well into the Christian era. John the Baptist Day is celebrated on June 24th, and John the Evangelist on December 27th. The Baptist was a zealous man, the Evangelist was a learned one. But both were Godly and had virtues that enhanced each other. This is the foundation, or Cornerstone for our first initiated Brethren. Where they are taught this valuable lesson of our Fraternity. That the spiritual cornerstone (you), will not rot or decay, but will remain true and square. Our operative brethren used the point to construct the circle. The square was tested for squareness by using a diameter and a point on the circle. This was a great secret to the Master Builders of Antiquity. Ultimately, this symbol truly becomes a test of our virtue.

I suggest you all start delving deeper into the symbology ever present just in our own Blue Lodge. There is MUCH more to look into regarding the Point Within a Circle, as well as each Patron Saints of Masonry and the days celebrated in remembrance of them yearly. I hope you all have a positive start to your summer for 2021, Lord knows we need it!




Committees




