

## EDITOR'S ARTICLE

#### **INTEGRITY TOOL**

As I travel with my masonic journey, I always ponder things about what I need to become a better man, how to be good and true mason or how to become a just or upright mason. With that in mind, I want to talk about one of our tools – The Compass.

The compass ability to forever point north is what makes it symbolic for travelers and for us in Freemasonry. The word 'compass' comes from the Latin word com which means together and passus which means step. This combines to mean to step together or travel together. By its very definition compass means to travel. This means it is an amazing symbol for travelers and those who travel together or meet each other on their journey.

Since ancient times when the compass was first created, it has been viewed as a symbol of safety and protection. It can always guide you home safely and protect you from getting lost. If you have a compass, you can never really get lost. It provides a sense of comfort and safety as you know you can always rely on it to point you in the right direction no matter where you are. Whether it is in the ocean, hiking through mountains or exploring unfamiliar roads. It is like the North Star, celebrated as a symbol of guidance. Having it means you will always know which way you are facing. With it you will always be able to orient yourself and get your bearings no matter how unfamiliar the location is that you are in.

Compass are a symbol vital to understanding Freemasonry. As the compass are used to draw arcs and curves needed by a builder, we must use them to draw the arcs and curves that symbolically serve as guidelines beyond which we should not venture. Let us use the word compass as it fittingly describes an instrument by which to find our way. Let us use the magnetic North as the baseline from which all other directions can be discovered. Everyone should use his internal Compass to direct his behavior. It can only be done with a strong sense of what is right or wrong and enable us to use the tool at our disposal as a baseline from which a course of moral righteousness can be followed, if that is our desired outcome. As Freemasonry is a system of morality, that is the direction that anyone seeking to join our Fraternity, or anyone already within, should strive to maintain. Also, in the teachings of Freemasonry, compass is symbolically employed to draw a boundary line around our desires to avoid overindulgence and maintain moderation. Which is the foundation of morality and wisdom.

As the compass is a symbol that always point us the right direction and draw the boundary lines, let this serves as a reminder to all brethren that acting "TRULY" towards others and balancing our own's needs will lead to a life of INTEGRITY.

#### CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT CALIFORNIA MASONIC CODE § 802.020 ARTICLE III – FEES AND DUES SECTION 2 (DUES)

Revised September 2023

To the Most Worshipful Grand Master of Masons in California:

This is to certify that at a Stated Meeting of this Lodge held on the date of <u>August 1, 2024</u>, the following Amendment to Article III, Section 2 of The Uniform Code of By-Laws of Lodges was presented in writing and noted upon the minutes of the Lodge:

Choose one option. (Mark an "X" next to the appropriate alternative.)

Section 2. The dues of each member of this Lodge shall be \$\_\_\_\_\_\_ per annum, payable in advance on the first day of January.

Or in the alternative;

\_\_\_\_Section 2. The dues of each member of this Lodge shall be the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ per annum, plus the Per Capita sum approved by Grand Lodge at the immediately preceding Annual Communication, payable in advance on the first day of January.

#### Or in the alternative:

\_X\_ Section 2. The dues of each member of this Lodge shall be the sum of \$\frac{\\$141.00}{\$}\$ plus the Per Capita sum approved by Grand Lodge at the immediately preceding Annual Communication, with the total thus determined, rounded up to the next higher whole multiple, of \$\frac{\\$210.00}{\$}\$, per annum, payable in advance on the first day of January. (Note: Proposed per capita for 2025 is \$68.50)

#### Certification

This is to further certify that the members of this Lodge are notified in writing that this Amendment would be voted upon at the Stated Meeting on the 7th day of November 20 24, and that said section will be amended by the vote of two-thirds of the members present on that date. The members of this Lodge understand that this Amendment shall have no effect until approved by the Grand Master and if a Lodge increases its dues, the increase shall become effective upon the start of the fiscal year of the Lodge following the Grand Master's approval of the increase.
